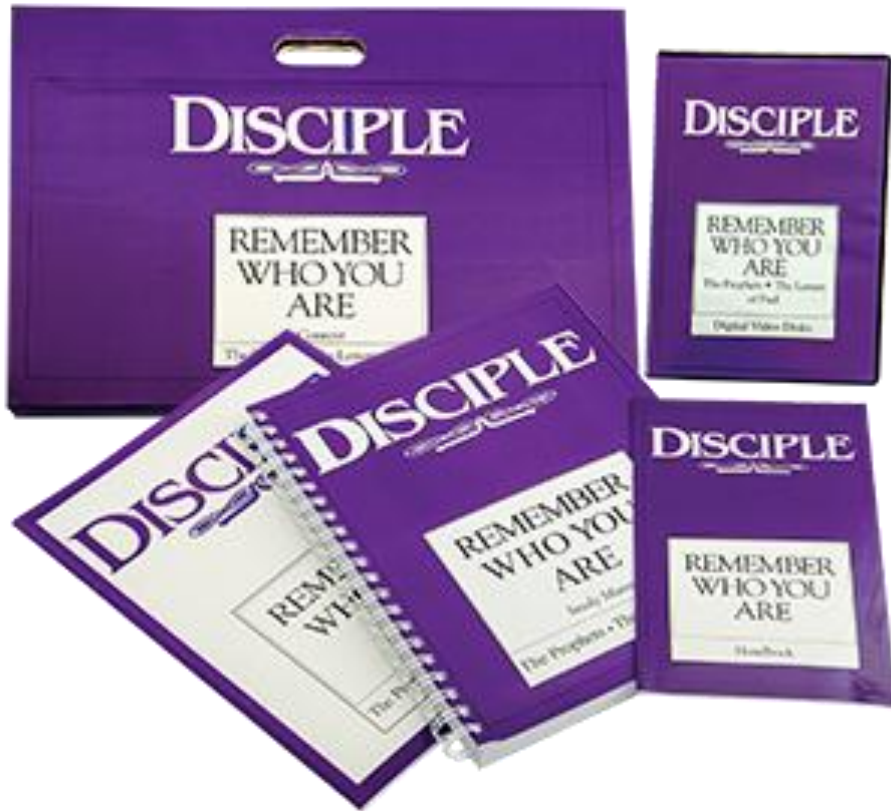

Facilitators: Pastor Paul Nga is a pastor of Trinity Methodist Church appointed from January 2015, and a Trainer with the DISCIPLE Agency. He has facilitated several rounds of DISCIPLE I, and has co-facilitated with Mr Philip Khoo DISCIPLE II, III, and IV, as well as Companions in Christ. Pastor Paul served as Chairman of DISCIPLE Agency from 2002 to 2008.

Mr Philip Khoo was received into the membership of Trinity Methodist Church in January 2017, and is a Trainer with the DISCIPLE Agency. He has facilitated several rounds of DISCIPLE I, II, III and IV as well as Companions in Christ. Brother Philip entered full-time church ministry with Toa Payoh Methodist Church in 1989 after retiring as Senior Assistant with the Ministry of Education. He served with Pastor Paul from 1990 to 1998 in Toa Payoh MC, and then again from 2000 to 2006 in Aldersgate MC.

(NOTE: DISCIPLE I is also pre-requisite for DISCIPLE II: Into the Word, Into the World; and DISCIPLE IV: Under The Tree Of Life).

Course Overview

DISCIPLE III: Remember Who You Are is the third study in the four-phase Disciple program. The driving idea in this study is the connection between memory and identity as the people of God. The word “You” in the title is meant to be heard both as “an individual” and as “the community”. We are a community of memory.

The Bible is the text for the study and the study manual will guide group members in their study and preparation for the weekly group session. The titles of the sessions along with theme words and theme verses, and major persons, events, and topics will set the sequence of the biblical story in the minds of the participants. The principal Scripture for each session follows the chronological movement of the biblical story.

"The Word of the Lord" picks up a familiar phrase from the prophets – a clear statement of their calling: They spoke (and speak) for God. Several themes weave their way through the study – the call to remember; the call to repentance; the need for renewed vision; and the place of community. The Prophets and Paul are continually calling hearers and readers back to their God and to a sense of who they are as a people "set apart."

Commitment & Participation ... 3.5-4.0 hours of independent study each week in preparation for weekly group meetings ... attendance at weekly 2.5 hour meetings.

DISCIPLE III focuses on The Prophets in the Old Testament, and the Letters of the Apostle Paul in the New Testament:
