Pastoral Epistle

"He appeared to them over a period of forty days and spoke about the Kingdom of God". These are tremendously significant words of Luke in Acts 1:3. They tell us that besides appearing to His disciples, the dominant activity of Jesus between His Resurrection and Ascension was that of teaching and training. So much so that in Acts 4, when Peter and John address the Jewish religious authorities in Jerusalem, they spoke like men trained in a theological seminary and vs 13 of that same chapter tells us that the Sanhedrin "took note that these men had been with Jesus".

Although Jesus spent much time ministering and preaching, and this we know through the Gospel accounts, what is not so obvious is the amount of time He spent teaching and training His disciples. But in Acts we find the fruit and evidence of this so clearly presented by the apostles' ministry in the Early Church.

This teaches us that teaching and training are to be dominant activities in the church as well. Christian Education is to be a primary priority in the church. And here we do not only think of Sunday School for it Involves Every Person in the community of faith. And That Means, dear friends, it involves You.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION involves adults as well as the young. So it is my prayer to see more Adult Bible Studies on Sunday. It is my prayer that God will raise up Leaders for these classes.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION involves the ministry of Small Groups. It is my prayer that many, many more will join in the training that is organised and begin such groups so that every person will be involved in a Small Group.
